
## INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS PARTICIPATING VIA ZOOM IN A LIVE BROADCAST CONCERT

- Any school can select the option to join a live broadcast concert via Zoom.
- Live concerts will be broadcast from the Helix, Dublin on Sat 7th and Sun 8th May.
- The orchestra will be live at the Helix while the choirs will zoom in to a video wall.
   Choirs will perform the full concert in their school and should be prepared to perform exactly as they would at a live in-person Peace Proms concert.
- Concerts will also feature instrumental and vocal soloists, dancers and our Drum and Pipe Corps, and will be conducted by Maestro Greg Beardsell.
- Choirs, should dress as they would for in-person concerts. Choir members must wear
  - o a plain white top shirt, T-shirt, polo shirt, or blouse (no logos)
  - o dark bottoms (trousers, skirt and tights, leggings, track suit bottoms)
- Teachers who wish to sing with their choirs should wear the same i.e. white top and dark bottoms.
- Choirs should ensure they are in place early, both at the beginning of the performance and after the interval.
- All songs and actions should be learned from memory.
- Principals, Teachers and Choir Directors should ensure that pupils and parents are aware that
  the performance will be broadcast live. It is essential that parental consent forms are completed
  for every child participating.
- Programme brochures will be produced as usual and will be available online as a FREE Download.

 All participating schools will be awarded certificates of participation signed by the Ministers of Arts and Education. Teachers can also download signed certificates of participation for all their choir members.



## **TECHNICAL**



- Choirs will be sent a Zoom invitation in advance. Choirs should log in early to ensure there are no technical issues.
- You should use a fixed phone / tablet or laptop focused on the choir to connect to the Zoom call. Use a table or tripod if possible.
- The Orchestra and conductor will be visible to your school via the Zoom call in full-screen mode.
- This should be displayed on a large TV / projector screen by connecting your device via HDMI port etc.
- Choirs should be watching / facing this screen.
- Our sound engineers will ensure that you will be able to hear a high quality live audio mix of the full orchestra for your choir to sing along with.
- Speaker volume should be at an appropriate level to accompany the children
- Please stay connected to the Zoom call for the duration of the performance, including the interval.
- If you wish, some external video cameras can also be connected to your computer / device and used as a webcam for improved video / sound.
- Please ensure devices are plugged in or have adequate battery
- Choir directors should ensure that every member of their choir can be seen.
- Please use choir risers if needed / available.
- Choirs should stand when they are singing and sit when they are not singing so they can watch the performance.
- Please ensure your background is as clear as possible
- Our Technical Team will manage the production and ensure that individual schools are featured on the livestream.
