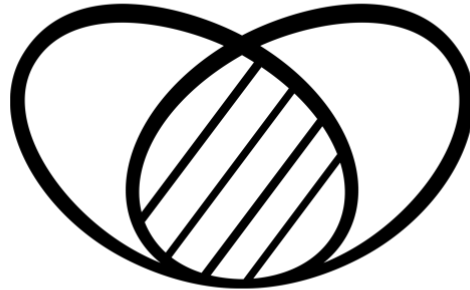

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# 1 CHOIR SCHEDULE

## 1.1 SAT 14<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2PM CONCERT

12:15pm 12:30pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Schools which have special seating requirements should arrive early.</li> <li>- All other schools, arrive.</li> <li>- <b>Please ensure you arrive early and use the toilet facilities</b></li> <li>- Entre through the TRACK doors and go to go straight to your places on the choir bleachers</li> <li>- <b>NB CHOIRS MUST BE IN THEIR PLACES READY TO SING AT 1PM</b></li> <li>- Once children are in their seats, they should remain in place until the end of the concert. ## 2 BEFORE THE SHOW - CHOIR DROP OFF

### 2.1 PARENT DROP-OFF

- Parents should drop choir members off by parking in **P7** and walking over to the **MAIN FOYER DOORS**. Parking is free for 90 mins. Parents should not park on the double yellow lines, as this will cause traffic congestion.
- Teachers should gather their group in **MAIN FOYER**
- Use toilets
- Avoid bringing coats or belongings. If your children have coats, they should be put large, labelled bin liners and stored behind the bleachers.
- Teachers should bring choirs to their places on the **BLEACHERS**.
- Choirs will be filled as they arrive, from the back.



### 2.2 COACH DROP OFF AND PARKING

- Coaches should have the name of the school on the front window on an A3 SHEET to allow teachers to find the buses easier on egress.
- **Coaches should use a one-way system: Entre through the 'flag-pole gates', go to P8 for parking or drop-odd, exit through the 'white pier' exit.**
- Coach parking is reserved for school buses in **P8**. **If there are any changes to coach parking, car park attendants will be on hand to direct and advise you.**
- Buses should park in **P8** before allowing children and chaperones to alight.
- Teachers should bring the children safely across the road and entre the arena through the **TRACK DOORS**.
- Use Toilets
- Avoid bringing coats or belongings. If your children have coats, they should be put large, labelled bin liners and stored behind the bleachers.
- Teachers should then bring choirs to their places on the **BLEACHERS**. Choirs will be filled as they arrive, from the back.



### 2.3 MAP

#### CAR PARKS

There are 1700 car-parking spaces at UL.

Parking is free at the weekend except in Car Park 7.



## 3 AFTER THE SHOW – CHOIR DEPARTURE

### 3.1 SCHOOLS LEAVING BY BUS

- a. All schools leaving on coaches will leave first through the **TRACK DOORS**. This will free up space for parents / guardians to pick-up their children.
- b. All other schools remain in their seats until those departing by bus have gone

### 3.2 SCHOOLS WITH SOME LEAVING BY BUS AND SOME LEAVING WITH PARENTS

- a. Teachers should know these details in advance. One teacher should look after the group going by bus, and leave quickly with them through the **TRACK DOORS**.
- b. The remaining teacher/s should follow procedure for parent pick-up.

### 3.3 PROCEDURE FOR PARENTS / CARERS IN THE AUDIENCE

- a. Audience will be requested to remain seated if they are picking up in the Arena or leave if they have no-one to pick up.
- b. Approx. 10mins after the show, parents will be invited to meet children in the arena, left and right of the stage area
- c. Parents/children can exit through **TRACK & MAIN FOYER DOORS**

### 3.4 PROCEDURE FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS NOT ATTENDING THE SHOW

- a. Parents / Guardians are asked to park in the main car park to keep main roads free from unnecessary congestion.
- b. Parents / Guardians should make their way to the main foyer where they will be held until school groups leaving on coaches have left the Arena.
- c. Approx. 10mins after the show ends parents / guardians will be invited to pick their children in the main foyer.

## 4 HELATH & SAFETY

### 4.1 SAFETY

UL campus security has asked that we make school authorities and bus drivers aware of the following safety concern: **"For events of this nature on campus, the safety of the children is of the utmost importance. Please be vigilant when dropping off and collecting of the children' under no circumstances will buses be allowed to use the roadway outside the Arena for this purpose"**.

### 4.2 LOST CHILD PROCEEDURE

1. Teachers should contact a members of the Peace Proms Team all of whom are connected by walkie talkie and will look for the child.
2. If the child is still missing after 10 minutes, the Peace Proms Team will contact Campus Security.
3. If the child is still missing after a further 10 minutes, Campus Security will contact the Gardaí.

### 4.3 EMERGENCY / FIRST AID / AMBULANCE

Emergency services are provided by Medilink. Trained paramedics and an Ambulance will be parked at the main entrance to the Arena during concert days.

## 6 GENERAL INFORMATION FOR TEACHERS

### 6.1 RECOMMENDED TEACHER/CHAPERONE : PUPIL RATIO is 1 : 15.

- There must be a minimum ratio of 1 Teacher to 15 Children with a minimum of 2 teachers per school.
- At least 1 Teacher will be required to remain with the Children at all times.
- We recommend that LEADERS allocate 15 children to each teacher so that each teacher knows exactly the 15 children they are responsible for.

### 6.2 SCHEDULE:

- Choirs should use the toilet facilities as soon as they arrive if necessary, and then go directly to their performance positions on the bleachers.
- Choirs who anticipate lengthy travel times will need to factor in comfort breaks and allow extra time.
- Choirs should be in their performance positions and ready to sing **1 hour** before the performance begins.
- The pre-concert rehearsal must start at the appointed time. Any choir arriving late will be allowed to join the rehearsal during breaks between songs.
- Choirs have a 30 minute rehearsal and 20 minute break before going on stage for the concert.
- Choirs should be in their performance positions 15 mins before the concert begins.

### 6.3 FOOD & BELONGINGS

- Children can bring water. There will be NO lunch break.
- Children should not bring coats or any belongings. (no rucksacks, school bags, hold-alls etc).
- Please ensure that all belongings e.g. coats are stored in labelled bin liners behind the bleachers.
- Please ensure that all belongings are kept clear of aisles, exits and fire-fighting equipment.
- Teachers sit with their group during the rehearsal and concert, and supervise them at all times.

**Teachers should sit at the end of the seat rows.**

### 6.4 CONCERT ETIQUETTE

- Teachers should switch off mobile phones before the concert starts. **Be sure to switch them back on at the end.**
- Children should not have mobile phones/tablets or electronic devices of any kind.
- No recording of the rehearsals or performance is permitted.
- Once the concert begins, the choirs remain in performance positions at all times. No one is permitted to leave the stage/risers before the concert ends.
- All Teachers/SNA/Chaperones in attendance should join in the singing and dance moves.
- Teachers should ensure that no rubbish or belongings are left
- Switch on mobile phones when the concert has ended.

### 6.5 CHOIR UNIFORM

- Choir members must wear a plain white t-shirt/shirt/blouse (no logos) and dark bottoms (uniform bottoms are fine – skirt and tights or trousers)
- On the day of the concert, choirs should arrive dressed in their choir uniform, as there are no changing facilities.

### 6.6 TEACHER UNIFORM

- Teachers should dress in semi-formal / cocktail black
- All teachers should have an ID badge giving the name of their school, their name and position.

### 6.7 TOILETS

- Choirs are asked not to leave their positions once the concert begins.
- Children should not be allowed to the toilet facilities unaccompanied. A teacher should accompany them.
